Criteria:

Distinguished service to University of the Built Environment

Exceptional contribution in support of University of the Built Environment

Connection with University of the Built Environment – affiliation or active involvement

University of the Built Environment alumnus that has given significantly to the sector

Contributed to University of the Built Environment in a meaningful way

Cannot be current staff, current students, serving Board members, or Honorary Degree recipients

University of the Built Environment Honorary Awards



Built Environment Award

Criteria:

Individual who has made a significant impact in the sector

Current high profile/standing within the sector

May have an existing relationship with University of the Built Environment but not essential – but willing to build a lasting and mutually beneficial relationship with the institution

Willing to undertake ambassadorial role for University of the Built Environment

Cannot be a serving University of the Built Environment Trustee



Honorary Doctorates

Criteria:

Someone of eminence who has made a significant contribution to the professions aligned with University of the Built Environment

Achievements relate in some way to the work or values of University of the Built Environment

Public profile that will benefit the reputation of University of the Built Environment

Exceptional service to the institution over extended time period but no requirement for direct link with University of the Built Environment prior to award

Potential for lasting and beneficial mutual relationship

Cannot be staff, serving Board members or Honorary Fellows
