Summary of changes 2025/26

The key changes for the 2025/2026 academic year are highlighted below. The changes include amendments and additions for clarity and futureproofing.

For clarity, additions are coloured in blue and underlined. Removals are coloured in red and stricken through.

The new regulations will be effective from **1st September 2025**.

3 Attendance and engagement requirements	Content from the section on Registration has been rescoped, and a new section specific to Attendance and Engagement has been included. This section also now defines specific requirements for those on apprenticeship and Master of Architecture programmes.
4 Registration	The following statement has been updated for clarity: 4.1. There is a registration deadline for each semester or year of study. The section has been rescoped to define specific regulations that do not apply to those on the Master of Architecture programme.
6.3 Extensions and late submissions	The following statement has been updated to reflect the regulations around integrated End Point Assessments i.e. where the University of the Built Environment is the End Point Assessment Organisation (EPAO) 6.3.1 You are allowed one seven-day extension for each module you are registered on. However, you are not permitted to use this extension if: - the assessment is a resubmission; or - the assessment is part of an integrated apprenticeship End-Point assessment module and it states explicitly within the Module Descriptors that no extensions are allowed. The following statement has been updated for clarity: 6.3.2 If you wish to use this extension, you must request this no later than the submission deadline original due date.
